Interim President Brent Brewer gave his report. The Interim President shared college updates in Academics, the Arts and Athletics. Mr. Brewer reported that the college served as hosts to the fourth annual futures fair and the upcoming MichMATYC (Michigan Mathematical Association of Two-Year Colleges), a conference which provides professional development for two-year college mathematics educators. After a two-year hiatus, the college will be relaunching the Academic Speaker Series. Interim President Brewer shared that the instrumental music faculty recital, the fall choral concert will take place this month and next. Mr. Brewer reported that in Athletics, volleyball currently has a 19-5 overall record, while SMC had the honor of hosting the MCAA Western Conference Cross Country Championship last month. Basketball and Wrestling season are underway and set to officially begin this month.
