Methodology/Definitions:

Full time students are taking 12 or more credits. Cohort is based on IPEDs definition of full time, first time degree or certificate seeking students. Graduation rates are calculated on completing an award within 150% of start time (typically defined as 3 years for an Associate degree.) The report looks at the status of the Fall 2019 FTIACs on August 31, 2022.
